Question: Regarding the value of contracts under construction, the estimate for 2008 is \$7,299.1 million,

which represents a substantial increase over the actual value of \$3,355.9 million for 2007.

Subhead (No. & title):

What are the reasons for this?

Asked by: Hon. LI Kwok-ying

Reply: The increase in the total value of contracts under construction in 2008 over 2007 is mainly due to the commencement of construction works for a number of large-scale projects in 2008.

These projects include:

(a) PWP Item 4092CD – Yuen Long, Kam Tin, Ngau Tam Mei and Tin Shui Wai drainage improvements, stage 1 phase 2B – remaining works. The approved project estimate is \$202.4 million.

- (b) PWP Item 4103CD Drainage improvement in Northern Hong Kong Island Hong Kong West drainage tunnel. The approved project estimate is \$3,044.7 million.
- (c) PWP Item 4111CD Drainage improvements in Tsuen Wan, Kwai Chung and Tsing Yi Tsuen Wan drainage tunnel. The approved project estimate is \$1,259.5 million.
