

Hypothetical examples of approved application

Example 1 - for TES Rate Matrix applicable on or before 31.7.2009

- Test results : $\text{COD}_{\text{total}}/\text{COD}_{\text{settled}} = 1000/780 \text{ mg/L}$
(i.e. $\text{COD}_{\text{total}} - \text{COD}_{\text{settled}} = 220$)
- First sampling date acceptable to DSD: 23.6.2008
- Period covered by water bill: 4.6.2008 to 5.7.2008
- From TES Rate Matrix : revised TES rate = $\$0.88/\text{m}^3$
- Effective date of revised TES rate : 4.6.2008
- Expiry date of revised TES rate : 3.6.2011

Example 2 - for TES Rate Matrix applicable from 1.08.2009 to 31.7.2010

- Test results : $\text{COD}_{\text{total}}/\text{COD}_{\text{settled}} = 690/590 \text{ mg/L}$
(i.e. $\text{COD}_{\text{total}} - \text{COD}_{\text{settled}} = 100$)
- First sampling date acceptable to DSD: 23.11.2009
- Period covered by water bill: 20.11.2009 to 17.03.2010
- From TES Rate Matrix : revised TES rate = $\$0.37/\text{m}^3$
- Effective date of revised TES rate : 20.11.2009
- Expiry date of revised TES rate : 19.11.2012

Example 3 - for TES Rate Matrix applicable on or after 1.08.2010

- Test results : $\text{COD}_{\text{total}}/\text{COD}_{\text{settled}} \text{ results} = 1500/1300 \text{ mg/L}$
(i.e. $\text{COD}_{\text{total}} - \text{COD}_{\text{settled}} = 200$)
- First sampling date acceptable to DSD: 7.11.2010
- Period covered by water bill: 6.11.2010 to 5.12.2010
- From TES Rate Matrix : revised TES rate = $\$2.77/\text{m}^3$
- Effective date of revised TES rate : 6.11.2010
- Expiry date of revised TES rate : 5.11.2013
